This document makes Queen Elizabeth II 'Queen of Australia', as the Assent to the Act changing the title set by the Royal Style and Titles Act 1953. It also eliminated both the reference to the United Kingdom, and the title 'Defender of the Faith'.

IT & Digital Privacy

Make you Windows computer more private using these settings

The Microsoft Windows system is basically a spyware system. You will never make it entirely private, but can be made more private by reviewing and enabling or disabling certain settings.

Below are the settings to check. The key settings are for all of us, while the hardening settings are for those that need to protect proprietary information or are threatened by the state. These should be right for Windows 10 and 11.

It's default state is: *High telemetry*, cloud-first, advertising ID enabled.

Key Settings to Review:

- Settings → Privacy & security → General → Disable all toggles (Advertising ID, Personalized content, App diagnostics).
- Settings → Privacy & security → Diagnostics & feedback → Set to Required only (Win11) / Basic (Win10). Disable Improve inking & typing, Tailored experiences, Diagnostic data viewer.
- Settings → Privacy & security → Location → Turn off Location for this device & restrict per-app access.
- Settings → AI features / Copilot → Disable if not used. Remove Web search from Start menu via Registry or Local Group Policy.
- Use Local Account during setup or convert existing account: Settings → Accounts → Your info → Sign in with a local account instead.

Pro Tip: Third-party debloaters (O&O ShutUp10++, Privacy.sexy) can disable deeper services but carry stability risks. Always create a system restore point first.
