From the Editor

This edition we have a summary of last meeting, how to make android phones more private, and the agenda for this coming meeting centered around **solutions**.

Actions and Connections

The meeting from 7 June included the presentation from John and Steve of TASA (Terra Australis State Assemblies) and Aunty Bucky.

Aunty Bucky spoke of the TWO STATE POLICY

- This refers to each having their own policies but recognising each others system
- We need to put a plan together to set the system up.

John demonstrated the Echo Radio's which have the ability to use the phone network but are encrypted making them an alternative to the telephones system.

The Echo radio works similarly to the CB Radio but only those with the Echo radio and added to the specific channel you are on can communicate with you or hear the conversation.

The price offered is \$99.00 per radio and can be purchased at the meetings by ordering and paying the money up front so the order can be placed.

John and Steve spoke about the solutions outcome from the Qld My Place Camp Out in May where it was identified that removing administrative controls - by lawful actions and how that can be achieved.

John identified the Act Interpretation Act 1901 s2 B - Definitions describes Australia as:

"Australia" means the Commonwealth of Australia and, when used in a geographical sense, includes Norfolk Island, the Territory of Christmas Island and the Territory of Cocos (Keeling) Islands, but does not include any other external Territory.

"external Territory" means a Territory, other than an internal Territory, where an Act makes provision for the government of the Territory as a Territory.

IT & Digital Privacy

Make your standard android phone more private using these settings

The version of android running on your standard manufacturer's phone (e.g. Google, Samsung, Oppo, etc) is very open out of the box, but can be made more private by reviewing and enabling or disabling certain settings.

Below are the settings to check. The key settings are for all of us, while the hardening settings are for those that need to protect proprietary information or are threatened by the state.

- **Default State:** High telemetry, Google Play Services deeply integrated, advertising ID enabled by default.
- **Key Settings to Review:**
 - Settings → Privacy → Permission manager → **Revoke** Location, Camera, Microphone, Sensors, Phone for non-essential apps.
 - Settings → Privacy → Ads → **Enable** Delete advertising ID and Opt out of Ads Personalization.
 - Settings → Location → **Disable** Location History, Google Location Accuracy, and Use precise location per app.
 - Settings → Google → Settings for Google apps → **Disable** Usage & diagnostics, Personalized recommendations, and Web & App Activity where possible.
 - Settings → Security & privacy → More security settings → **Enable** Auto-reboot (limits cold-boot extraction) and Block USB data when locked.
 - Settings → System → Developer options → **Disable** USB debugging, OEM unlocking, and Bluetooth HCI snoop log after initial setup.
- **Hardening Additions (Medium/High Risk):**
 - Use a privacy-focused DNS app (NextDNS, Intra, or RethinkDNS) to enforce encrypted DNS system-wide.
 - Install `shelter` or `Insular` to create a work profile for isolating Google-dependent apps.
 - Disable or freeze Google Play Services components you don't need via `adb` (advanced users only).
 - Use `NetGuard` or `AFWall+` (root) to block per-app internet access.
- **Pro Tip:** For Medium risk, consider using GrapheneOS or CalyxOS instead of hardening stock Android. Stock Android hardening is a stopgap; replacing the OS provides structural

privacy gains.
